

## MINUTES FROM THE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 PRE BOARD MEETING

- I. Meeting to Order Jon Jenz
- II. Financial Update Kevin East
  - 1. Financial documents were disclosed and discussed. The entire board will have regular access to these documents for the sake of transparency and accountability.
  - 2. Katie Clark will no longer be bookkeeper.
    - a. Board votes unanimously to remove Katie Clark from the the HOA bank account.
    - b. Board votes unanimously to add Jon Jenz, Pine Ridge Estates Board President, to the Pine Ridge Estates Bank account.
    - c. Board votes unanimously to consolidate the savings account into the checking account.
- III. Road Discussion Bob Giebel
  - 1. White lines on Lance Lane mark areas bid for repair.
  - 2. 7 companies were contacted and 3 responded. Board votes unanimously to choose Advanced Sealcoat and Paving, which offered the best price for the most comprehensive repair options.
  - 3. Board votes unanimously to move forward with work costing up to \$55,000 that includes repairs to Lance Lane, drainage work, and caliche for increased road width to minimize future damage.
- IV. Financial Future at PRE Kevin East and Board
  - 1. Covenants allow board to increase dues up to 25% per year. (Jon)

- 2. Board votes unanimously to present the HOA with a vote on whether or not to make road assessments permanent and merge with HOA dues to be paid quarterly or annually.
- 3. Board votes unanimously to present the HOA with a vote on whether or not to increase road fees from \$500 to \$1,000 annually.
- V. ACC Updates Bob Giebel
  - 1. New builds likely 2 upcoming and another nearing completion
  - 2. Gates
    - a. Codes will be cleared and reassigned for security purposes by January 1, 2022.
    - b. Contact Bob if in need of a gate remote.
- VI. Upcoming Elections (1st Quarter 2022)
  - 1. VP Position up for election. Seat will be vacated.
  - 2. Treasurer Kevin East intends to runs again.
  - 3. ACC Jenifer Hendrix intends to run again.
  - 4. Make Road Assessment permanent.
  - 5. Increase Road Assessment to \$1,000 annually.
